SET-UP DAY THURSDAY FEBRUARY 12

Arrive by 12:30 PM to begin set-up.

- Set-up will conclude once everything is complete.
- Sign in and sign out to log service hours.
- Enter through the South parking lot.

Facility Guidelines and Childcare

- No scotch tape, thumbtacks, or staples on walls or floors.
- Limited National Honor Society (NHS) Childcare will be available for ages 2 through 2nd grade on set-up day only. Sign-ups will be available next week at CCA.
- Students are welcome at set-up but must have a job to do. Students may not run around during set-up.
- Some parents prefer to keep History Day a surprise for the day of the event. Please keep this in mind when deciding whether to bring children.



MINIMUM PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENT

- Each family must complete a minimum of 5 service hours between set-up day and History Day.
- Parents who do not assist with their assigned booth will be addressed by the Head of School and may be fined.

Exceptions are made for illness or emergencies.

- Please self-monitor for illness.
- If you or your child is sick, stay home and text 941-229-0927.

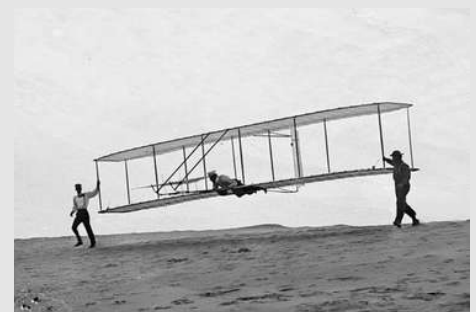
Trash and Recycling
